Dowell the above Plat of 62 1/2 Acres by virtue of a Land Office Treasury Warrant of one thousand acres, N^o 1598 Obtained 22nd September 1795 the Land lying in Rockbridge County on the Big Half Pasture River adjoining the Lands of John Dunlap William Jamison Andrew Graham, William Nesbit deceased and Robert Say and is bounded as followeth *Viz*, Beginning at a double maple on the North East bank of said River near to John Dunlaps corner running thence near his line N 37° E 318 poles to two chesnut oaks on William Jamersons line thence his line S 49° E 76 poles to two pines & chesnut N 49° E 30 poles to two Chesnuts oaks N 10° E 40 po. to 4 Ch. O. on said Jamersons line th. leaving the same N 77° E 61 poles crossing a Spring Branch to two red oaks on Andrew Grahams line th. his line S 15° W 21 poles to two double chesnuts S 86° E 80 poles to two white oaks & a ch. o. N 38° E 158 to 2 Ch. O. on a ridge by a Path, thence leaving said Grahams line S 77° E 89 po. along the top of said ridge to two hickories by said Path on William Nesbits line th. his line S 57° E 148 po. to a large Wh. O. Nesbits corner th. New line S 28° W 68 po. to 3 Wh. O. in a flat by a small branch

branch thence crossing the same S 39° W 82 poles to a wh. 0 on a ridge, thence up
the same N 86° W 107 poles to a 6 horned th. S 46° W 170 poles to two white
oaks on Robert Gays line, th. his lines S 61° W 224 poles to 2 pines & a P. C. said
Gays corner wh. S 14° W 28 poles to a double maple on the big half Pasture River
thence up the several courses of said ^{River} 188 poles to the beginning
